Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the Applicant to use *Det Norske Veritas'* (DNV) Rules, International Maritime Organization Safety of Life at Sea requirements and the 1989 Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit (MODU) Code with Amendments to 2001 for the fire detection systems in lieu of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 72E, Standard on Automatic Fire Detectors, as referenced in the regulations provided that while operating in the Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador offshore area, the maintenance will comply with any extra requirements of NFPA.
