The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the Applicant, the owner of the Seven Havila, to use a dynamic position reference system onboard that alarms based on a worst case consequence analysis for the Seven Havila in accordance with Det Norske Veritas Rules for Classification of Ships Part 6, Chapter 7 and Dynamic Positioning Systems with Notation DYNPOS-AUTHR (IMO II) in lieu of the requirement to display the percentage of power on the thrusters.
