Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer exempts the Applicant, the Operator of the Hebron Installation, from installing a motor-propelled rescue boat onboard provided the Operator:

- Can demonstrate a level of reliability for the two motor propelled rescue boats to be installed onboard each of the standby vessels through use of performance standards to the satisfaction of the Chief Safety Officer.
- Completes an assessment identifying all credible scenarios that would require rescue from the water and addresses the requirement of close standby including the necessary training and communications for the crew of the standby vessels within the operational requirements of the Hebron Safety Plan.
- 3. Ensures measures are included in the Hebron Safety Plan to mitigate the risk of a person falling overboard to as low as reasonably practicable.
- 4. Ensures measures are included in the Hebron Safety Plan to retrieve persons from water preventing injury to as low as reasonably practicable, including drills.
