Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer/Chief Conservation Officer authorizes the Applicant, the operator of the SeaRose FPSO, to use Det Norske Veritas standard DNV OS F101, Submarine Pipeline Systems for the design and installation of Gas Injection Rigid Flowline for South White Rose Extension in lieu of *National Standard of Canada CAN/CSA-Z187-M87, Offshore Pipelines* as referenced in the regulations.

Approval of this regulatory query should not be interpreted to mean that the amendment to the White Rose Development Plan respecting the South White Rose Extension has been approved. A separate Development Plan Amendment approval is required.
