

Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer concurs with the Applicant's proposal to conduct hot work operations onboard the Terra Nova FPSO during production shutdowns provided all risk reduction measures outlined in the Application are followed. The Application has been approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Subsea facility must be shut in, blown down and depressurized and the topsides process equipment must be depressurized
2. Only residual amounts of hydrocarbons will be present in the cargo tanks (less than 7%) and the tanks must be kept full of inert gas during the shutdown period unless otherwise approved.
