I have one comment on the scoping document pages 7-8 notes the following:

“Traditional historical fishing activity, including abundance data for certain species in this area, prior to the severe decline of many fish species (e.g., a general overview of survey results and fishing patterns in the survey areas for the last 20 years);”

Given that some of the commercial fish stocks in the project area closed in the early to mid-1990s than a review of the past 20 years will not adequately show the picture for all fisheries prior to the severe Decline. A review including the 1980s would provide a better historic fishing pattern.
