What we do every day

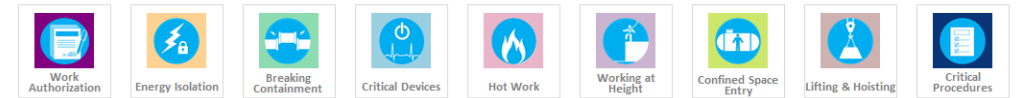
Operational Integrity Management System (OIMS)

- Foundational to how we protect people and the environment
- Foundational to how we evaluate risk
- Required to maintain our Licence to Operate
- Key to change to performance based regulations

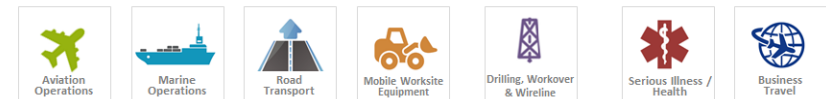

Process Safety Actions



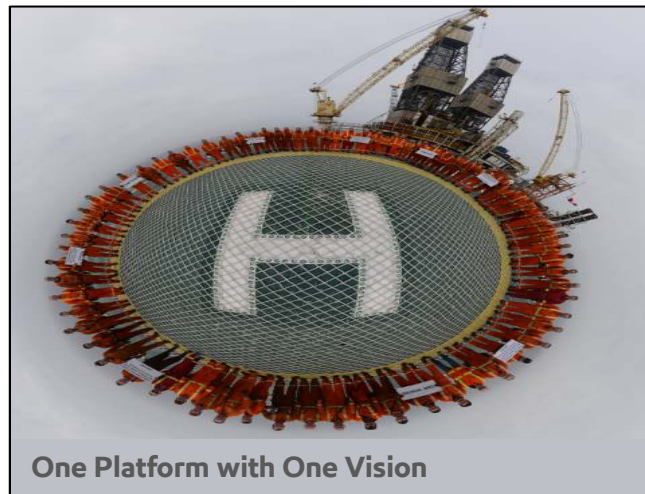
High Consequence Exposures



Incident Sharing

- Daily communicator; Morning calls
- SSHE Safety Message; Incident summary call
- Management & Co-venturer reviews
- Safety forums with C-NLOPB & Operators

What we do every day



How Can We Prevent Dropped Objects

- Ensure DROPS Inspections are completed on a scheduled basis
- Ensure secondary retention methods are applied to objects at height
- When working at height, do a quick visual check of all objects around you for fixture / fitting integrity
- Ensure scaffolds have toe boards installed
- If you observe an object that does not have secondary retention (netting / wire), or the primary retention is degrading, report it to your supervisor immediately and complete a NGH Card
- Ensure your tools are tethered when:
 - Working above 1.8 m
 - When working on a scaffold or working platform;
 - When working 1 m from a leading edge
