It's good news that TGS is committing to having a seabird observer on the ship during the program, but that letter makes no mention of the protocols that will be used. We recommend that the proponent use the pelagic seabird monitoring protocols that were previously provided by CWS, in order that the data obtained will be able to be integrated into the regional database. I expect the lack of mention was just a writing oversight, but it is an important thing to mention in case they are thinking of implementing different protocols.
